

Tips when teaching your infant-toddlers:

1. To keep an infant's attention span focused on the activity, one idea is to give them something quiet to hold in their hands. Such as a spoon, pacifier, small lovey or toy.
2. Have your infant sit in their highchair when teaching or doing art activities to avoid them crawling away.
3. Use a lot of expression and excitement in your voice when teaching to catch and keep their attention!
4. If your child does not show any interest, do not force. Re-visit the lesson activity again at another time.
5. Keep lessons short and minimal to retain attention span. At this age, the attention span is roughly 5 minutes.
