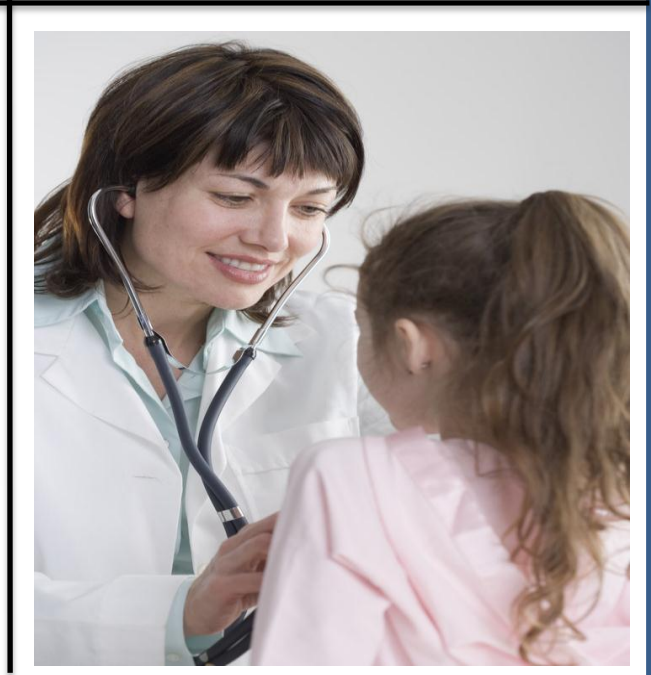


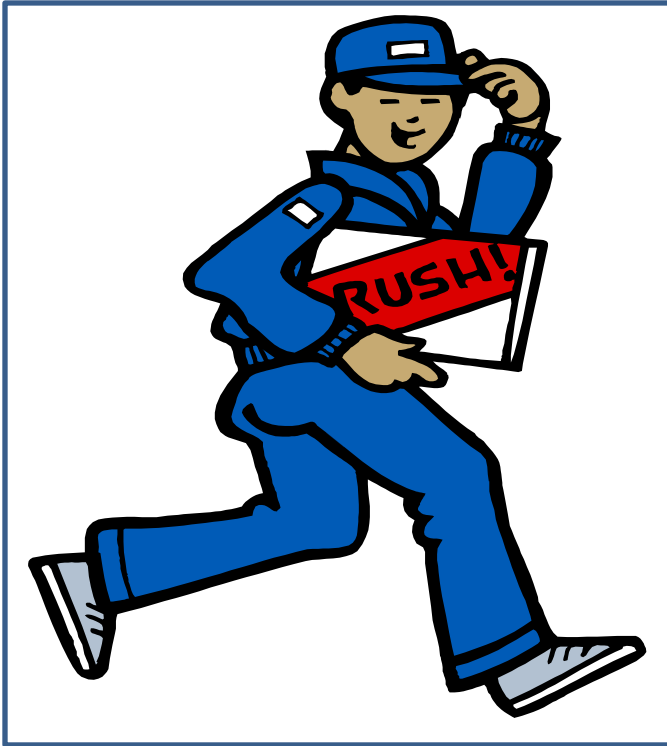
To make Popsicle Song Puppets: Use these as props when singing the song “Five Little Helpers”. Cut each box out individually. Glue each picture to the end of a real popsicle stick. Hold up to show child while singing; or, for older children, they can hold on own while singing. This type of teaching style increases a child’s visual ability to learn a new concept, while hearing the name of it. Song is on the next page.
