For infants and toddlers: Teach the words in both Spanish and English using the word-picture cards. Find these same objects around your house and say their names again in both Spanish & English.

For preschoolers: Teach the picture words in both Spanish and English using the word cards. Then, have your child practice writing these words out on a white sheet of paper. Have them draw the picture that associates with the Spanish word they are writing. Such as, if they are writing out the word “cama”, have child draw a picture of a bed next to the word after they write it. Remember to teach these words using both Spanish and English. They can even write the English word next to the Spanish word on the sheet of paper, such as writing the word “bed” next to the picture of a bed they drew and word “cama” written out. You may have to help your child spell the English word for each of these objects out in order for them to write them. Have them use these word cards to refer to Spanish spelling of them.
