

Can cut word cards out or leave in this order if preferred. Teach your child the days of the week, saying the words in both Spanish and English. Directions at the end for each age group.

For infants and toddlers: Teach the words in both Spanish and English using the word-days of the week cards. Sing the song below to your child to teach the days of the week easily and fun!

For preschoolers: Teach the days of the week in both Spanish and English using the word-days of the week cards. Then, have your child say the words, spelling out the days of the week in Spanish (refer to the cards for child to point to each letter while spelling the word out). At the end, have your child practice writing these words out on a white sheet of paper. Remember to teach these words using both Spanish and English. They can even write the English word next to the Spanish word on the sheet of paper. Sing the song below to your child to teach the days of the week easily and fun!
