

Telling Prompt Cards

Cut cards out individually. Put in a bag. Pull one out at a time. Use these if your child is not able to write yet; you ask them what's on the card, they answer it by telling you using their words, and you write down what they say. Then re-read back to them what they "wrote" (said) afterwards.
