All about Apples!

Seeing: Show your infant three different colors of real apples. Say the colors as you hold each of them up for your infant to see.

Touching: Allow your infant to pick up the apples; grasping them.

<u>Tasting</u>: Boil apples to make them soft enough and cut them up in small cubes for an infant to eat for snack OR give them applesauce!

Smelling: Bake a hot apple pie for dessert tonight, the smell that will surround your house, your infant will be sure to love!

<u>Hearing:</u> Make sounds with your words that describes what it sounds like when eating an apple. Eat an apple next to your infant, bite the apple near their ear, and make the sound with your words to teach infant what is happening. Sound words may include: "Crunch!" "Chomp!" "Bite!" and "MMMM, Juicy!"
