

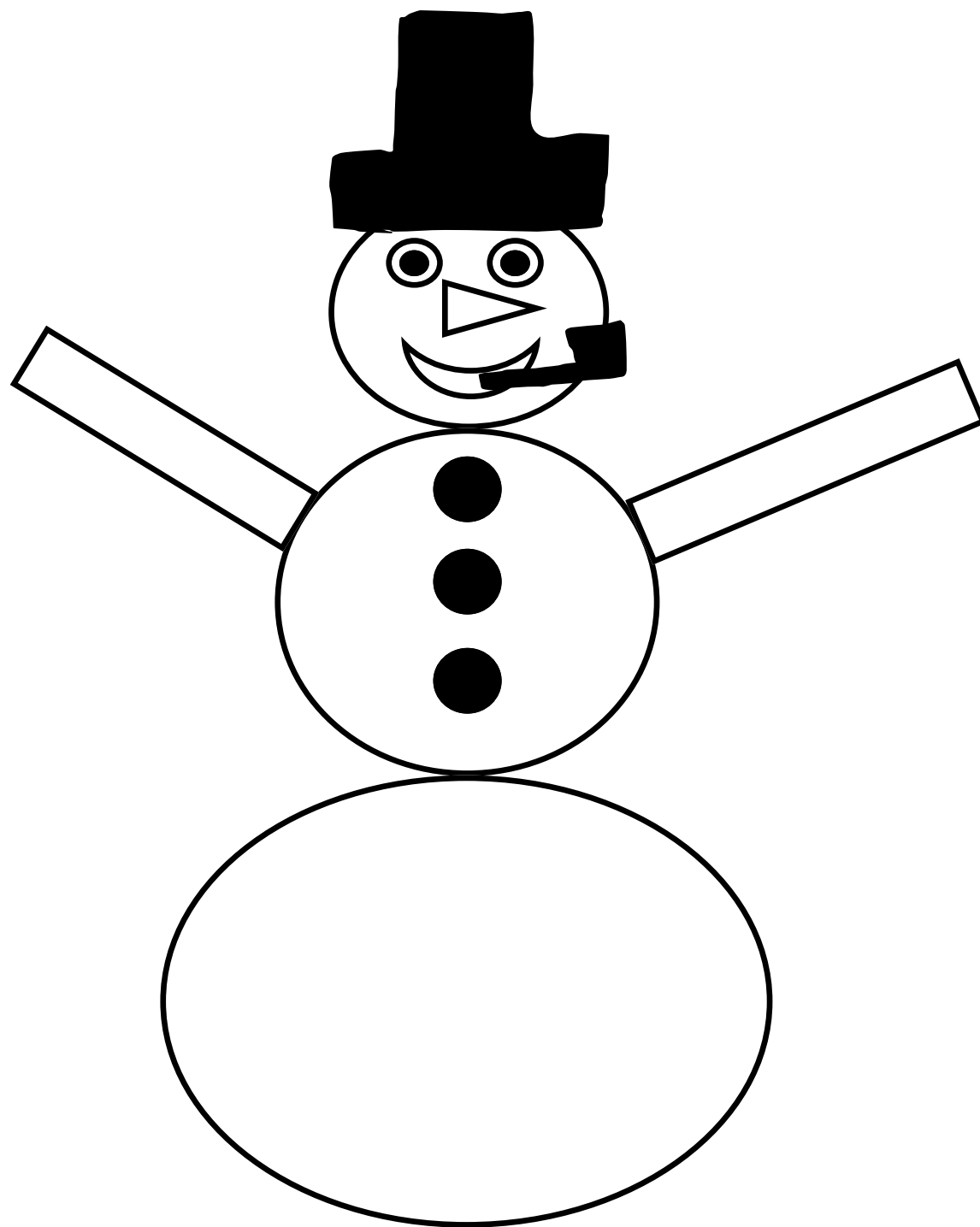
Building a Snowman

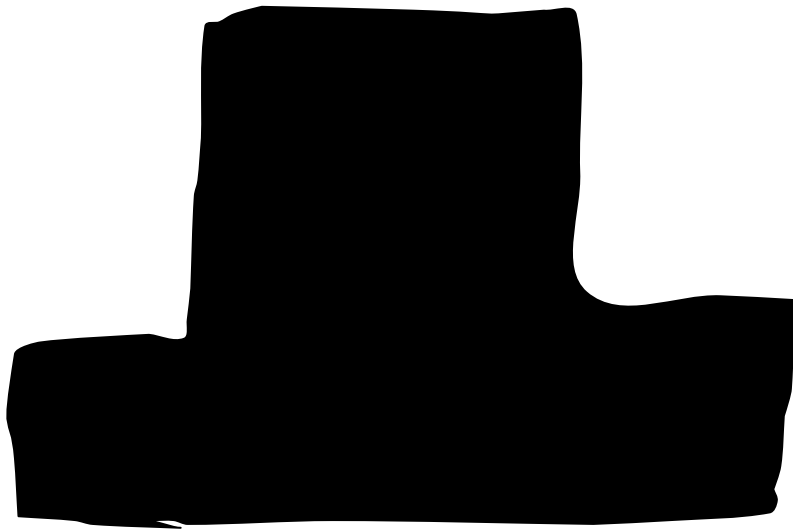
Cut these each out individually first. Discuss each of the pieces shape with your child. Use full picture as a guide to teach & color.

For infants: Hold up one piece at a time, say its shape to your infant, and tape it up to the window or wall low for them to see. You are going to build the snowman together while telling each parts shape to your infant.

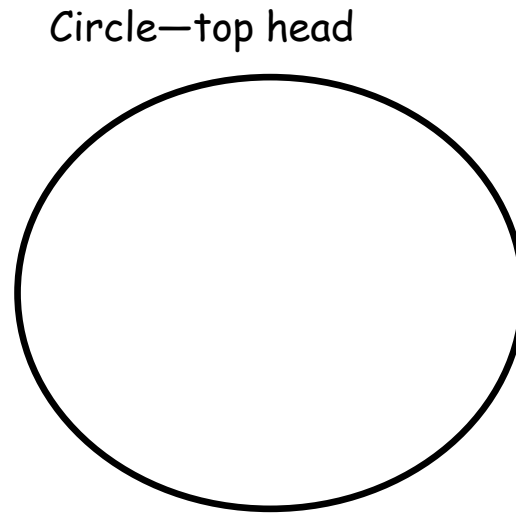
For toddlers and preschoolers: Have them color if desired, and then glue the pieces together on a white or blue sheet of paper building the snowman together. Parents: Do NOT tell child where the pieces go; let them think creatively and put it together the way they see it. Help with glue as necessary—teach “a dot will do”

After completed: Sing Frosty the Snowman together!

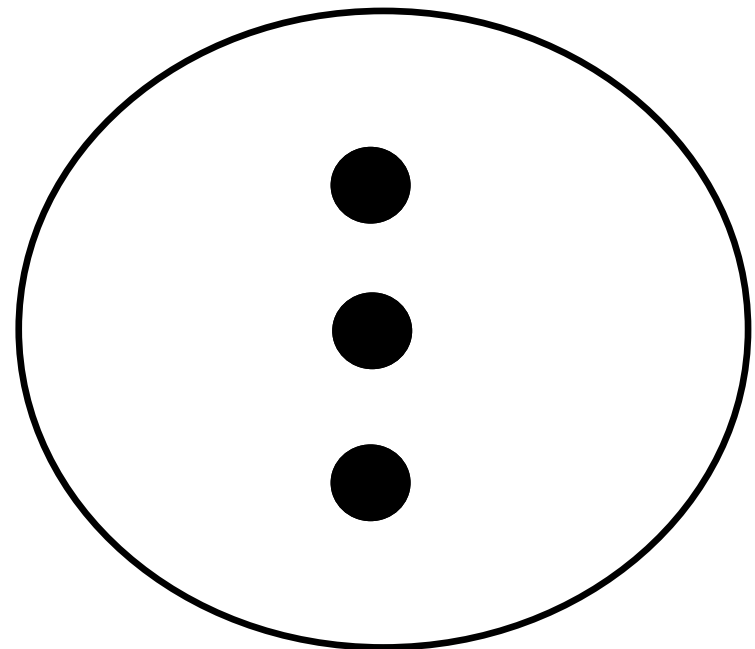




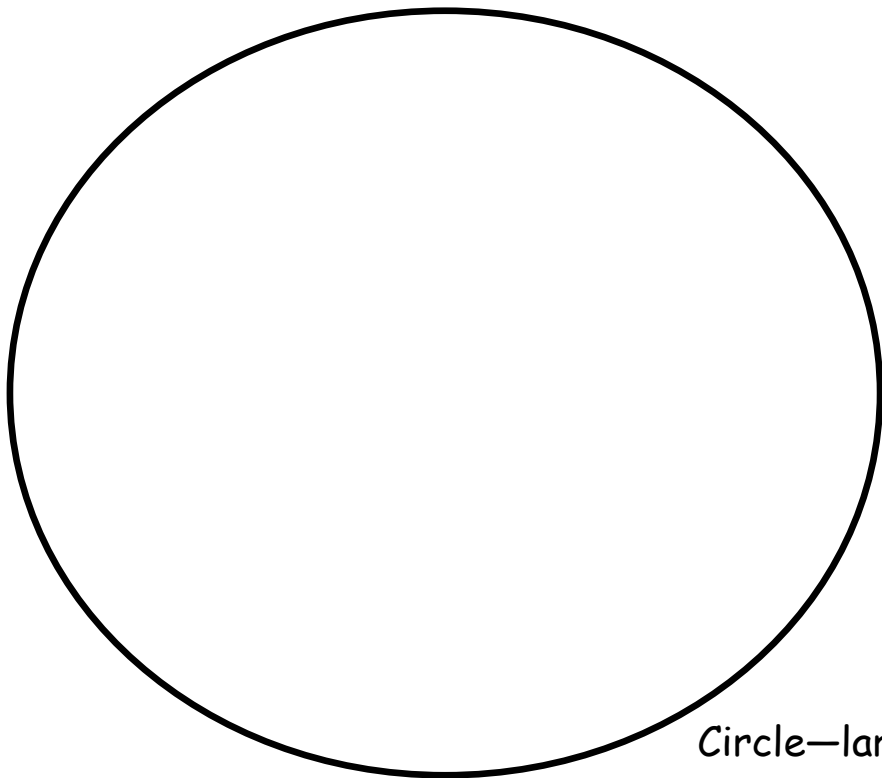
Rectangle—hat

Circle—middle body

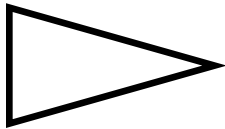


Circle—large bottom body

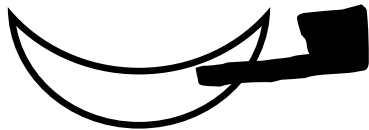
Circle—eyes
