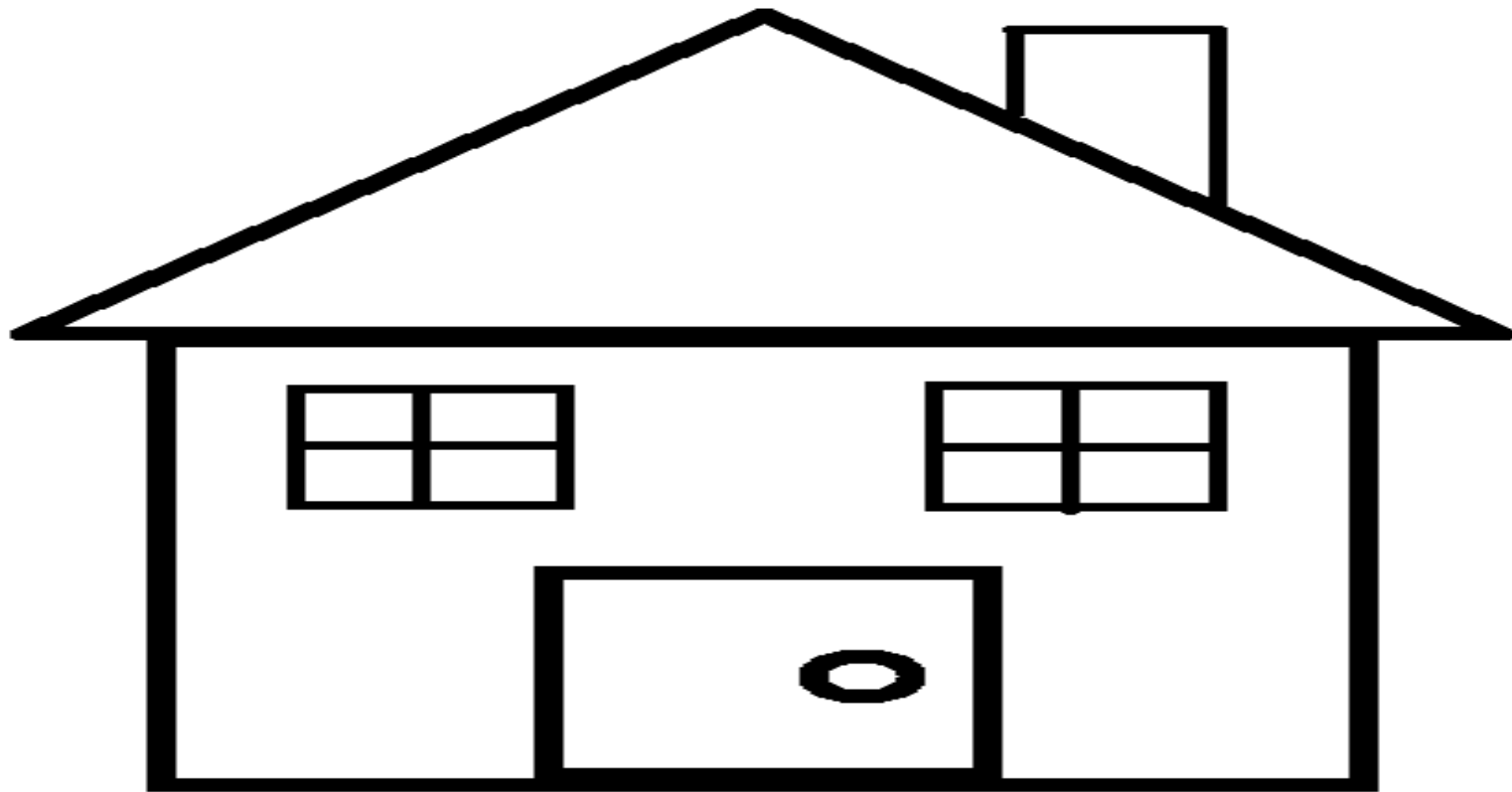
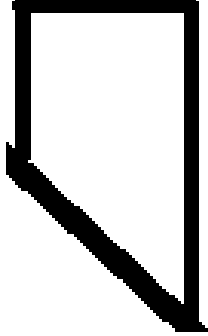


# Build My Home

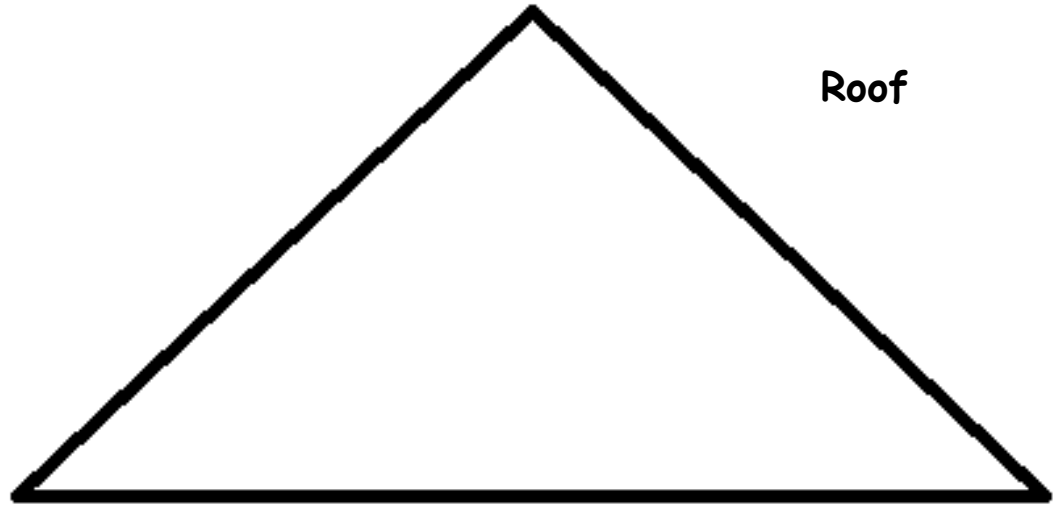

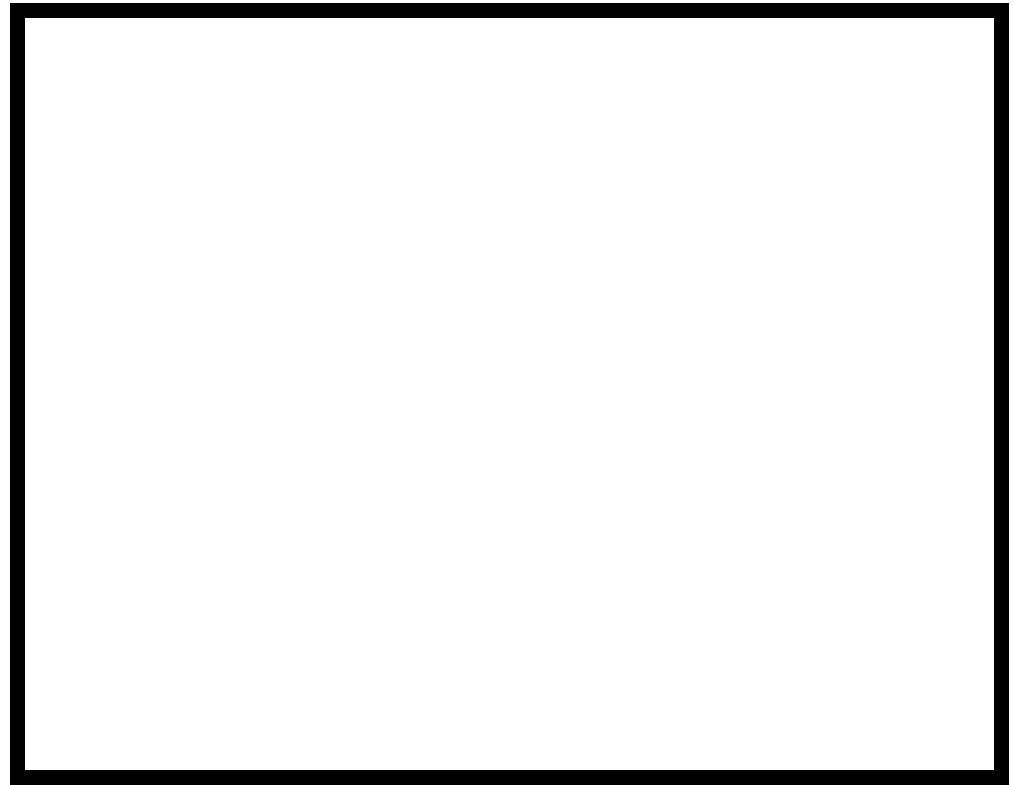
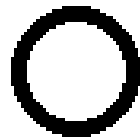
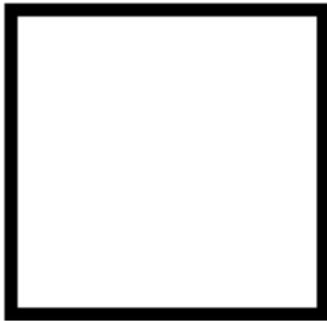
Roof
