## Feather Counting

Cut each of these feathers out. Practice counting with your child.
Infants count only \#1-5. Toddler \#1-10. Preschoolers and up \#120.

## Other ways to use these feathers:

You can also use these to sort colors, make patterns, and learn the colors names.

Have your child hold one of the feathers. Go on a scavenger hunt around the house looking for objects/things that are of that same color. This builds color awareness and language development.

Use these feathers for adding and subtracting practice.
Craft idea: Use these feathers to glue on a paper plate, draw a face for a turkey in the middle, and make a puppet-plate turkey!
