## 5-day Teaching Guide Infant

<u>Day 1:</u> Read the story to infant, only saying the words on each page and point to the pictures.


<u>Day 2:</u> Say the word on the page, clap the word out, and then spell it out to your infant. Repeat this same process for each word on each page.

<u>Day 3:</u> Say the words on each page and point to the pictures. Use the word on each page in a sentence. Such as: "The balls are round."


<u>Day 4:</u> While looking at the pictures, describe what colors and shapes you may see in the pictures and count them on each page to your infant.

<u>Day 5:</u> Look around, in and out of your home, to find the real objects that are mentioned in the mini-book. Show and tell your infant what they are. Such as going outside and pointing up to the sun to teach infant where and what the sun is. Re-read the book again for a last time.





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
