



ABC Block Game

Ages 3 years to 4 years

Objective: The child begins to recognize the alphabet while using fine-motor skills to roll a block, find, and match letters.

Materials needed:

White paper plates (6)

Black Sharpie Marker (you will use only)

Block pattern (printable)

Procedures:

1. Before hand: Print block pattern, and fold together to make a "cube." Write these letters on each side of the cube, AaBbCcDdEeFf (capitol and lowercase of each on same side)
2. On each white paper plate, using the sharpie, write the letters AaBbCcDdEeFf (one letter for each plate, capitol and lowercase on each).
3. Model by doing first in front of your child, roll the cube block. See what letter the cube lands on heads up. Have your child say that letter out loud.
4. Then place cube on the matching letter plate.



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4. Hand the cube to your child, let them roll it.
5. This game teaches them concepts of print and early math matching skills. Not to mention following a set of directions!!!
6. Have your child continue this pattern: Roll cube, say letter name, put on matching plate....continue....
7. **Optional:** Print out cube block again, write other letters on it for practice with your child. Do until they show no interest anymore.

Milestones to meet:

The child begins to recognize letters. The child can roll a cube. The child can match same letters. The child can say letter names when shown.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
