ABC Play dough Ages I year to 2 years


Objective: The child is introduced to the alphabet while using play dough to explore and create.

Materials needed:

Play dough Small Popsicle sticks Plastic Knife Picture examples on next page **Procedures:**

- 1. Have your child sit in their high chair for this activity.
 - 2. Give them one color of play dough. With your child, start flattening it out, rolling into balls, tear into pieces, and squishing it in your hands. See if they imitate your actions. Help their hands to do these actions if they do not imitate.
 - 3. Now using the popsicle sticks, flatten out the play dough into a circle shape. Press the letter "A" using the sticks into the dough. Say the letter. Do other letters (T, U, L, N are easy).

4. Let them explore and create with the popsicle sticks and play dough freely.

5. Using a plastic knife, carve out the letters into the play dough flattened out. Say the letter as you cut it out. Ask them to try and repeat saying letter.

Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters. The child can use fine-motor skills to explore and manipulate play dough.
