ABC Science Ages 3 years to 4 years

Objective: The child begins to recognize the alphabet by following steps in the scientific method.

Materials needed:

ABC Scientific Method (printable)
ABC's Chart (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Read to your child the "problem card." Show them the chart of how the letter "A is after B and C."
- 2. Show them the correct alphabet. Say each letter pointing to them, and have them repeat.
- 3. Now read them the "guess card."
- 4. Now read them the "solution card."
- 5. Have them follow the steps on all of the scientific method cards: problem, guess, solution, conclusion.
- 6. Help your child solve the problem by showing them the real alphabet and the way it looks. Don't tell the answer; help them to figure it out.

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- 7. Sing the alphabet with your child. Ask them after singing, what is the FIRST letter? Then what comes next? (i.e. A is first....then B and C. So A is actually BEFORE B and C.)
- 8. Have your child point out where A is on the ABC's chart to visually show them it comes first/before.

Optional Activity: For the letter V-Volcano. Go to our Messy Madness Area of this website.

There is a volcano science experiment. Do it with your child. They will love seeing the lava explode!

Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to the science concept of "problem, guess, solution, conclusion." The child learns and understands the concept of before and after. The child can solve a problem.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
