

Objective: The child is introduced to the letters in their name after exploring them in water.

Materials needed:

Large bowl, spoon, and plate

Water

Magnetic Alphabet Letters-you can get these at Wal-Mart or Dollar Store in the Learning Section **Procedures:**

- 1. In the bowl, put about 1 cup of water. Add in the alphabet letters in your child's name.
- 2. Show them by modeling first, use the spoon and scoop one letter at a time onto the plate.
- 3. Say the letter as you scoop it out. Ask them to repeat letter after you.
- 4. Hand them the spoon. Have them practice scooping out letters from the water onto the plate.
- 5. Continue until all letters in your child's name are on the plate. You can add more in the water as desired, if your child still seems interested.



Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters in their name. The child tries to repeat some of the letters & sounds and listens to their name spelled out. The child can use their sense of touch to explore and fine-motor skills to scoop objects out and transfer.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
