

Objective: The child is introduced to the alphabet through a story.

Materials needed:

ABC eStory (eBook &/or Printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Put your child in your lap to sit. You can choose to pull the eBook up on your computer or Kindle and read with child directly from the screen and/or Print it out.
- 2. Read through the story book with your child. Look at the pictures only. Say what they are while pointing to it showing your child. See if they know what the picture is first. Have them repeat what the picture is using their words.
- 3. Now read it! Have them say/repeat each letter.
- 4. Point to each letter as you say it to your child. This type of reading style helps your child to understand what you are saying has a meaning behind it, and also helps their understanding of concepts of print.



Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters. The child can listen to a story about the alphabet and tries to repeat letters out loud. The child says and recognizes a few of the pictures in the story.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
