

Objective: The child builds literacy skills and development after hearing a variety of stories.

Materials needed:

Visit your local library or Book Store Today!

Procedures:

- 1. Today, take your child on a field trip to your local public library or book store (Barnes N Noble or Borders).
- 2. Find books that are about letters or ABC's.
- 3. For a child, books with colorful, big pictures are the best!
- 4. Show and read a variety of these kinds of books to your child, discussing picture details using as few words as possible to do so (simple describing for this age is best!) Point to and say each of the alphabet letters that you see.



5. If your child does not sit very well or listen to stories with you, put the books on the floor, sit on the floor next to the books and start looking at one by yourself; and when you infant see's your interest in them, they will more than likely come to your lap and show interest in looking at the books too!

Milestones to meet:

The child can listen to a story. The child begins to learn the alphabet and letters; recognition.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
