

Objective: The child begins to build language awareness and literacy skills by pulling letters off the wall.

Materials needed:

Sticky Notes Black Marker

Procedures

- 1. Sit with your child on the floor for this activity. Pre-write out the letters in your child's name. One letter written on each sticky note of its own using the black marker.
- 2. Put them up on the wall, low for your child to grab and reach, and as you stick them up on the wall say the letter to your child.
- 3. Once all of the letters have been said and stuck up for your child to see, encourage them to grab at them and pull them down. As they pull them down one at a time, say that letter to your infant again as they reach for it. View picture on next page for an example of what to do.

Milestones to meet:

The child begins to build literacy skills and early language awareness by seeing and hearing letters. The child uses fine-motor

skills and hand-eye coordination to pull letters on paper they see down off the wall.
