## Pull it out of the bag Ages I year to 2 years

**Objective:** The child is introduced to the alphabet after playing a hide-n-seek game finding letters. **Materials needed:** 

Brown paper bag Small white index cards (25) Black Marker

### Procedures:

- Before hand, write the alphabet A-Z, so that each letter is written on 1 white index card of its own. All capitol or both is fine. Place in bag.
- You will have to model first showing your child what to do before they will be able to do it themselves.
- 3. Grab in the bag and pull out a letter. Show your child that letter and say it out loud.
- 4. Keep doing it until they show interest to try and "pull a letter out" themselves.
- 5. Once they do, say the letter to them and ask them to try and repeat what it is to you. Say: "Can you say A?"

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6. Continue until all letters have been pulled out or your child does not show interest any longer.

#### Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters. The child uses fine-motor skills to grab objects. The child builds their sense of object permanence. The child shows a willingness to try and repeat letter names after heard and seen.

### **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
