

Objective: The child is introduced to the alphabet by placing letters on matching letters.

Materials needed:

5 paper plates Black sharpie marker (you will use only) Sticky Notes

Procedures:

- 1. Before hand: Write the capitol letters only A B C D E on the paper plates. One letter per plate. Do the same letters on the sticky notes. One letter per sticky note.
- 2. With helping your child, hand them the letter "A" sticky note. Have them find the matching letter "A" paper plate and stick it on it.
- 3. Have child continue with letter B C D and E.
- 4. If your child shows extreme interest, make more with other letters of the alphabet. OR you can do the letters in your child's name.



Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters. The child can match same letters. The child uses fine-motor skills to stick paper on objects.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
