


Objective: The child is introduced to the alphabet.

## Materials needed:

ABC Chart (printable)

## Procedures:

- 1. Start by sitting with your child on the floor.
- 2. Sing the ABC's to your child, normally.
- 3. Sing it again, but whisper it.
- 4. Now sing it again for a 3rd time, but sing it faster than usual. Encourage child to sing too!
- 5. Show your child the ABC chart.
- 6. While pointing to each letter, sing the ABC's for a 4th time, normally.
- 7. Hang the ABC Chart on the wall, low down, for your child to see in their bedroom.
- 8. Occasionally throughout this month, sing the ABC's to your child, while pointing to the letters on the chart. Encourage child to sing with you.



## Milestones to meet:

The child is introduced to letters and begins to make awareness for the alphabet. The child shows physical reaction when sung to. The child tries to mimic and sing along with you.

## **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
