



Kinds of Houses

2 year—3 years

Objective: The child builds early reading skills through storytelling about homes in our community.

Materials needed:

"Kinds of Houses" Storybook (eBook printable)

Procedures:

1. If you do not have a printer or ink, you can pull up the storybook and read to teach your child straight from the computer while they sit on your lap.
2. Begin reading the book. Point to each of the pictures when you say the name of the type of home to help child understand the word through pictorial representation.
3. Go through the whole storybook with your child. Re-visit this story more than once this week to really begin teaching concepts, and help them develop awareness & understanding.



Kinds of Houses

2 year—3 years

Milestones to meet:

The child can listen and look at a story being read to them. The child begins to build early reading skills through hearing a story and seeing pictures about what they are hearing to make the connection. The child can repeat words after heard in a story. The child shows early reading skills by looking at pictures and telling what they are.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
