Community Helpers 1 year 2 years

Objective: The child develops awareness for people in our community after seeing pictures.

Materials needed:

Community Helper Pictures (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Have your child sit in their highchair for this activity or on the floor with you.
- 2. While showing your child each picture of the community helpers, say to teach your child who the picture is of.
- 3. Build language awareness in your child by describing what kinds of things each of those people do for us. Tips of what to say are on the left hand of the page.



4. Continue this same way teaching community helpers to your child.

Hearing new words and phrases builds language capacity for future development in young children.

Milestones to meet:

The child shows visual development through looking at pictures of everyday people in our community, and auditory development hearing new words and phrases about people they see.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
