

Objective: The child will develop and use social and self-help skills after spinning a wheel with community helper ideas and complete the tasks landed on.

Materials needed:

Community Wheel (print from resources page)
Pencil or spoon as a "spinner"

Procedures:

- 1. On the board, lay the "spinner" down.
- 2. Have your child spin and tell them whatever they land on is the community helper task they have to complete this week, or for the day.
- 3. Have child spin. (Tip: The spinner "heads" on a pencil would be the led end; or for a spoon would be the spoons end)
- 4. Read to child what they land on.
- 5. Have, or help them, do the task.
- 6. Continue again for more fun, more volunteering.



7. Have your child spin until each "task" spot has been landed on and completed, if desired.

Milestones to meet:

The child can use social skills to complete a task in their community. The child uses self-help skills to do things that require helping others. The child can spin an object. The child follow directions.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
