



Counting Community Helpers

2 years to 3 years

Objective: The child begins to develop math skills by counting pictures of community helpers.

Materials needed:

Counting Community Helpers Sheet (printable)
Tape

Procedures:

1. Recommended for this age, only count from #1-10.
2. Cut out the community helper pictures to count.
3. As you count them with your child, you are going to put a small piece of rolled up tape on the back of each "helper picture" and then tape it to the wall (door, fridge, or wherever you choose to teach and show).
4. Show your child the person, put tape on back,



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put it up on the wall, count it out loud; ask your child to count the #s with you.

4. Continue this same way of teaching and counting until you have counted all the way up to 10.

5. You should have 10 pictures of community helpers displayed up for your child to see.

6. Once they have all been shown, taped, displayed, and counted individually, go back pointing to each picture and count them again all together, #s 1-10 with your child.

Milestones to meet:

The child can count from 1-10. The child shows a willingness to count from #'s 1-10 with you.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
