

Objective: The child will learn same and different after matching community helper pictures.

Materials needed:

Matching Pictures (printable) Print twice Crayon or Marker

Procedures

- 1. Have your child sit at a small table.
- 2. Help your child understand the way each of the community helpers look on the printable sheet. Which ones are the same? Which ones are different? Why and how? Discuss these things first with your child.
- 3. Next, model to show child what it is you want them to do. Match the community helpers that are the same together by tracing the line from one to the next. Use your finger to demonstrate to child how to trace the lines first.
- 4. Help child trace and complete the sheet.
- 5. Print another sheet out and allow child to do it all on their own this time. Watch and facilitate.



Milestones to meet:

The child shows understanding of matching similarities by using words and tracing a line from one picture to the other.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
