

Objective: The child can build early reading skills through storytelling about community helpers.

Materials needed:

"Little Helper" Storybook (print from resources page)

Procedures:

- 1. If you do not have a printer or ink, you can pull up the storybook and read to teach your child straight from the computer while they sit on your lap.
- 2. Begin reading the book. Point to each of the pictures when you say the name of the community helper to help child understand the word through pictorial representation.
- 3. Go through the whole storybook with your child. Re-visit this story more than once this week to really begin teaching concepts, and help them develop awareness & understanding.



Milestones to meet:

The child can listen and look at a story being read to them. The child can build early reading skills through hearing a story and seeing pictures about what they are hearing to make the connection.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
