

**Objective:** The child can match pictures that look similar on their own.

## Materials needed:

Crayon or Marker

Matching Community Helper Pictures Sheet

(print from resources page)

## Procedures:

- 1. Have your child sit at a small table for this activity.
- 2. Explain to your child to draw a line to the matching pictures on the sheet.
- 3. Help as necessary.
- 4. When doing each one, ask your child what the name of it? Who drives or uses the item in the picture? Then have them draw the line to the matches.



- 5. Continue this same way teaching and doing each of the matching pictures with your child.
- 6. After your child's drawn a line to all of the matching pictures, go back and ask them what each of the names of the pictures are again.
- 7. Turn the sheet over, have your child draw a picture of their favorite safety vehicle (i.e. police car, fire truck, ambulance) to increase drawing and fine-motor skills for future "writing" development.

## Milestones to meet:

The child can draw lines from one object to the next. The child can tell you what things are in our community they recognize by looking at a picture of it. The child can match similar looking pictures.

## **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
