



Matching Pictures

4 years to 5 years

Objective: The child can match pictures that look similar on their own.

Materials needed:

Crayon or Marker

Matching Community Helper Pictures Sheet
(print from resources page)

Procedures:

1. Have your child sit at a small table for this activity.
2. Explain to your child to draw a line to the matching pictures on the sheet.
3. Help as necessary.
4. When doing each one, ask your child what the name of it? Who drives or uses the item in the picture? Then have them draw the line to the matches.



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5. Continue this same way teaching and doing each of the matching pictures with your child.

6. After your child's drawn a line to all of the matching pictures, go back and ask them what each of the names of the pictures are again.

7. Turn the sheet over, have your child draw a picture of their favorite safety vehicle (i.e. police car, fire truck, ambulance) to increase drawing and fine-motor skills for future "writing" development.

Milestones to meet:

The child can draw lines from one object to the next.
The child can tell you what things are in our community they recognize by looking at a picture of it. The child can match similar looking pictures.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
