

Objective: The child can look at pictures that belong together, match them, and say what they are.

Materials needed:

People and Places Matching Cards (print from resources page)

Tape and Scissors (you will use only)

Procedures:

- 1. Before beginning lesson, cut out all of the people and places cards individually.
- 2. Sitting with your child, show them a picture of a person in our community. Ask them to say the name of that person (i.e. "Who is this a picture of?")
- 3. Put a piece of rolled up tape on the back of that picture, and tape it up to the wall so your child can see it.
- 4. Now hold up the matching place picture which associates to your child the person just shown.



- 5. Ask child the name of the place and the name of the person that works there. (i.e. "What is this a picture of? What kinds of people work there?")
- 6. Continue teaching: Repeat process by putting a piece of rolled up tape on the back of the place picture, and tape it up to the wall next to the person it matches with.
- 7. Continue until cards have been gone through.
- 8. Once complete, go back through them to re-visit; ask your child to say the name of the person and place they work.
- 9. Ask child for further understanding: "Why do they need that place to do their job?"

Milestones to meet:

The child can match pictures of things that go together. They can use their words to say the names of people & places they recognize in their community.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
