



# Washing Windows

## Ages 1 year to 2 years

**Objective:** The child begins to develop life-skill concepts of helping wipe down windows in their house.

### Materials needed:

Yourself and your baby!

Low window in your house

Small towel

Window cleaning spray (Parent will use only)

### Procedures:

1. Put your child in front of a low window. Model and show your child what you want them to do. Holding the towel, put cleaning spray on the window then wipe it down.
2. Give your child the towel, help guide their hands as necessary to wipe down the window.
3. Parent continues to spray the windows slightly, while the child helps wipe them down.



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4. Keep encouraging and teaching your child how to wipe down windows after you spray them. Then, you can teach them how to wipe down tables to help you clean up.

### **Milestones to meet:**

The child learns the life-skill of helping. The child can grab a towel and make a wiping type of motion to clean a spot.

### **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
