

Objective: The child will be able to talk with their parents about what they want to be when they grow up after creating a book together.

Materials needed:

When I Grow Up Scrapbook (print from resources page)
Crayon, Pencil, or something to write with

Procedures:

- 1. Sit with your child at a table.
- 2. Start on page one.
- 3. Have child sign their name on the line.
- 4. Read to them the question or statement on each page, have them tell you their answer, as you write it in filling in the blanks.
- 5. Allow your child to illustrate the book as necessary per page.
- 6. Keep in your child's baby book as a memory when they get older!



Milestones to meet:

The child uses social skills to talk with others about things they enjoy, and what they want to be as they grow up. The child can answer a question or fill in a statement ending with their own thoughts. The child can "sign" and write their name.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
