BIBLE BUBBLES

WEEKLY LESSON 1

"Don't just believe in God. <u>Believe</u> God."

GALATIANS: All who rely on observing the law are under a curse, for it is written. Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law.

Ask your child these questions, hear their answers or help them to come up with them:

- 1. How do we know God is with us?
- 2. What can we do to talk with God?
- 3. Does God answer our needs? How?
- 4. What makes God happy?
