WEEKLY LESSON 1

"We honor the Son, by honoring the Father."

JOHN 5: The son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing. Whatever the Father does the Son also does. For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does.

WEEKLY LESSON 2

"Heaven is great!"

REVELATION 7: For the Lamb at the center of the throne will be their shepherd, he will lead them to springs of living water. And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

Make a "Heaven" art picture with your child. Talk about how Heaven is a beautiful place where God lives. It has angels and is bright and nice. For activity: On a white sheet of paper, have your child glue cotton balls, flowers, and lamb and angel stickers onto it. Let child create freely on own.

WEEKLY LESSON 3

"Love must guide all that we do."

ROMANS 12: Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Practice hospitality. Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

With your child, define what love means to you and your family. What is love? Make a list of ways you can show love to each other. Have your child give love to someone. Give a homeless person a piece of bread, or have them help hold a door open for someone at the store.

WEEKLY LESSON 4

"If God is part of our planning for things we do in life, He will sweep all obstacles out of our way."

CHRONICLES 14: God has broken out against my enemies by my hand -David

Have your child create a plan of what they want to be when they grow up and what steps they think they need to take to get there. (I.e. If your child says they want to be a doctor when they grow up, steps would be to say: go to school and college, work in a hospital, & practice helping people get better)

WEEKLY LESSON 5

"Keep the bad away and worship to the Lord."
