

Objective: The child can build fine-motor skills and creativity by painting and creating a tree craft.

Materials needed:

Christmas Tree (printable)
Green paint & paint brush
Craft Supplies such as; beads, buttons, pompom
balls, glitter, holiday stickers, sequins
Glue

## **Procedures**

- 1. Have your child sit at a small table.
- 2. Put the tree printable in front of your child.

  Ask child Q: "What is this a picture of?" A: Tree
- 3. Put some green paint on a paper plate.
- 4. Have child paint the tree green.
- 5. Let it dry completely.
- 6. You can add dots of glue and have your child put the craft items on the glue dots on the tree; as a form of decorating it with ornaments and lights.
- 7. Let it dry completely again.
- 8. Hang for holiday décor around the house!



## Milestones to meet:

The child can use fine-motor skills and handeye coordination by painting a picture and putting items on glue. The child builds creativity skills.

## **Evaluation:**

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
