

Objective: The child builds auditory awareness through song and visual representation.

Materials needed:

Santa and Songs (printable)

Popsicle sticks (2)

Tape or Glue

Procedures:

- 1. Before hand, cut out the two Santa pictures and glue or tape them to the ends of two popsicle sticks.
- 2. You will hold one and encourage your child to hold one.
- 3. Sing some fun holiday songs with your child using the pictures as props!
- 4. For Hanukkah, using the picture, hold it up in front of your child (or show from the computer screen while they are sitting in your lap). Point to each candle and count them to your infant. Let them color or finger paint it afterwards!



Milestones to meet:

The child builds auditory development through songs and rhyme. The child can grab and hold a popsicle stick picture puppet on their own. The child shows a willingness to sing along in songs. The child shows a willingness to color or finger paint a picture.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
