



# Snowman Shapes

## Ages 1 year—2 years

**Objective:** The child builds early math skills by seeing and hearing shapes.

**Materials needed:**

Snowman Shapes (printable)

Scissors

Tape

**Procedures**

1. Have your child sit on the floor with you next to a low window, blank wall, or mirror.
2. Before hand, cut out all of the snowman shape pieces from the printable sheet.
3. You are going to hold up each shape one at a time to show your child, say the name of the shape, and then tape it up to the wall or window. Do this same thing until the whole snowman is built. Ask child to "repeat" the shape words after you.
4. After the snowman shapes have been taught and built up for your child to see, encourage them to grab at and take down each of the shape pieces; repeating the name of them out loud for your child to hear the shapes name.



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## Ages 1 year—2 years

### Milestones to meet:

The child learn about shapes after seeing and hearing the names of them; the child tries to repeat or say the shapes name they hear. The child uses hand-eye coordination to grab at a shape picture and pull it off the wall.

### Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
