



Gummy Bears Sorting

Ages 4 years—5 years

Objective: The child will match same colors using Gummy Bears candy and sorting them on a graph.

Materials needed:

Gummy Bears candy (1 or 2 packages)

Gummy Bears Sorting Graph (printable)

Procedures

1. Sit with your child at a table for this activity.
2. Put all of the gummy bears on a paper plate.
3. Put the graph down in front of them.
4. Go over all of the colors at the bottom of the graph with your child first. Child names colors.
5. Now model and show. Pick up one of the gummy bears and put on the graph in the appropriate colored column.
6. Encourage and tell your child to sort the gummy bear candies based on their colors on the graph.
7. Help your child to do until all of the bears are on the graph in the correct color columns.

Milestones to meet:

The child can sort similar colors on a graph using Gummy Bears. The child recognizes and knows their colors by name.
