



Valentine's Day Card

Ages ALL

Objective: The child will use their hands and feet to create and imprint.

Materials needed:

Marker to Write "Happy Valentine's Day"

White paper

Red and White Paint (if you don't have paint at home, you can use white glue, red food coloring, and a small amount of water to mix together to make it)

Procedures:

1. Using the paint, either all one color, or one color on each hand, apply paint with a brush or your finger to your child's hands (both).
2. On the white paper, take both of your child's hands and put them together with their palms touching, hands slightly facing outwards making a heart-like shape. You may have to overlap their hands to get the full effect of a heart.



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Fingers should be facing up-wards and closed.

3. When you are done, wash their hands thoroughly. And yours, too!

4. Do this same way of painting and printing using their feet on the white paper, making a heart print. (Toes up; feet touching at heels only)

5. You can have them (or you do it) sign their name on it and write out "Happy Valentine's Day"

6. This is a cute keepsake for your child's baby book. Happy Valentine's Day Mom and Dad!

Milestones to meet:

The child uses their body parts to engage in creative forms.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
