

Objective: The child is able to create structures using different objects.

Materials needed:

Popsicle sticks (skinny and small) Large Marshmallows

Procedures:

- 1. On a table or surface that is easily cleanable, lay out the popsicle sticks and marshmallows on a large tray or plate.
- 2. Let your child build with these. You may need to model first by sticking the sticks in the ends of the marshmallows and creating some sort of structure.
- 3. Let them build and create on their own. See what they come up with!
- 4. Be sure to talk about what they built and discussing why they choose to build it.



Milestones to meet:

The child is able to use fine-motor skills to build structures with objects.

Evaluation:
