Seasonal Sorting Ages 4 to 5 years

Objective: The child can recognize the different seasons when show pictures. The child is able to sort pictures according to seasonal attributes.

Materials needed:

Seasonal Cards (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Begin by going over the four seasons. Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall discussing what they are.
- 2. Now show your child the picture cards. Discuss each one, explaining the details that associate with that specific season it falls under. (i.e. snow=winter, colorful leaves=fall, beach=summer, sun=summer, flowers=spring, and so forth)
- 3. Have your child sort the picture cards independently according to which season it goes under, by placing them in same groups.

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4. Continue until all card have been sorted correctly.

Remember to discuss details, using adjectives to describe what you see in the pictures, why it belongs under that seasonal category.
Look at all of the <u>similarities</u> in each group of pictures for each of the seasons and talk about them. Now discuss the <u>differences</u> in all of the pictures for all seasons.

Milestones to meet:

The child is able to sort pictures based on their seasonal attributes and recognizes similarities, differences, and attributes in seasons.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
