

Objective: The child expresses themself through music, beats, and rhythm.

Materials needed:

Popsicle Song Puppets (printable) You will have to make these before hand, which requires cutting them out and gluing them to popsicle sticks

Procedures:

- 1. Follow the directions on the popsicle song puppets to do with your child. Choose to do any or all of the different song puppets.
- 2. You can sing your own songs too.
- 3. Make sure when singing the songs you emphasize the "rhyming words" so they understand that songs have a certain pattern to them.
- 4. If you have a kids song CD that has a lot



of rhyming words with it, play it for your child and make sure you sing along.

Milestones to meet:

The child increases their language capacity through songs and repetition of certain sounds (rhyming words) and beats (patterns in the songs lyrics)

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
