



Songs and Rhyme

Ages 2 to 3 years

Objective: The child expresses themselves through music, beats, and rhythm.

Materials needed:

Popsicle Song Puppets (printable) You will have to make these before hand, which requires cutting them out and gluing them to popsicle sticks

Procedures:

1. Follow the directions on the popsicle song puppets to do with your child. Choose to do any or all of the different song puppets.
2. You can sing your own songs too.
3. Make sure when singing the songs you emphasize the "rhyming words" so they understand that songs have a certain pattern to them.
4. If you have a kids song CD that has a lot



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of rhyming words with it, play it for your child and make sure you sing along.

Milestones to meet:

The child increases their language capacity through songs and repetition of certain sounds (rhyming words) and beats (patterns in the songs lyrics)

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
