

Objective: The child begins to recognize opposites when show pictures. The child is able to match opposite pictures together.

Materials needed:

Opposite Cards (print from resources page)

Procedures:

- 1. Begin by explaining to your child what the word "opposites" mean. Opposites: Things that are related differently. "It can be...or can be (or) It is not...It is"
- 2. Show your child the opposite picture cards. Keep the matching opposites together using phrases such as stated above when showing opposites. (i.e. It is not <u>cold</u>...It is <u>hot</u> (or) It can be <u>morning</u>...It can be <u>night</u>)
- 3. Continue until all opposite cards have been gone through with your child.



- 4. Lay all of the cards face up on the floor.

 See if your child can match the opposites together.
- 5. Assistance is okay! Just keep using specific phrases as mentioned which helps with language association and building the capacity knowledge of what "opposite" means.

Milestones to meet:

The child is able to match opposite pictures together. They begin to understand the concept of opposite.
