



Seasonal Sorting

Ages 3 to 4 years

Objective: The child begins to recognize the different seasons when show pictures. The child is able to sort pictures according to seasonal attributes.

Materials needed:

Seasonal Cards (print from resources page)

Seasonal Sorting Chart (print from resources page)

Procedures:

1. Begin by going over the four seasons. Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall
2. Now show your child the picture cards. Discuss each one, explaining the details that associate with that specific season it falls under. (i.e. snow=winter, colorful leaves=fall, beach=summer, sun=summer, flowers=spring, and so forth)
3. Have your child sort the picture cards independently according to which season it goes under, by placing them on the correct box on



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the sorting chart.

4. Continue until all card have been sorting correctly.

5. Remember to discuss details, using adjectives to describe what you see in the pictures, why it falls under that seasonal category.

6. Look at all of the similarities in each group of pictures for each of the seasons and talk about them. Now discuss the differences in all of the pictures for all seasons.

Milestones to meet:

The child is able to sort pictures based on their seasonal attributes.
