



Picture Album

1 year to 2 years

Objective: The child uses prior knowledge of familiar people and says the names of people they recognize.

Materials needed:

Family photos

Procedures:

1. Go through family photos of people in your family: mom, dad, sisters, brothers, grandmas, grandpas, cousins, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, pets, ect.
2. As you go through them one at a time showing your child, point to the person in the photo and say their name. Ask your child to repeat the person's name after you. ("Can you say ma-ma?")
3. Do not say anyone's name as you flip through the photo album or pictures; let your child tell you who they see, or you may point to someone and ask child "who is that?"
4. Go through as many pictures as you have, or until your child no longer shows interest.



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Milestones to meet:

The child can make a personal connection to familiar faces and recognizes family members. The child can say a familiar person by name after seeing a picture of them.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
