



# Say and See Cards

## Ages 1 year—2 years

**Objective:** The child is introduced to real-life items and objects that we may have and builds language development.

### Materials needed:

Say and See Picture Cards (printable)

### Procedures:

1. Cut out all of the say and see picture cards individually.
2. One at a time, hold up to show your child and say the name of it to them. Go through until all are shown and said. Ask child to try and repeat name of each picture card after you.
3. If you have the item on each card at home, show your child a real-life object and say its name to your child.
4. Use these say and see pictures cards at other times to show/tell/teach your child.



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### Milestones to meet:

Does the child show learning through their sense of hearing and sight, by making a reaction when shown items/objects and listening to the names of them? The child builds new knowledge with items they may experience in their everyday lives. The child tries to repeat words after heard.

### Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
