



# Story time

## 2 years to 3 years

**Objective:** The child builds early language skills after hearing a story and can say words of things they see and recognize in a story.

### Materials needed:

eStorybook "I love to learn" (printable)

### Procedures:

1. Print out the book and staple together. (you can also do this activity straight from the screen at your computer instead of printing)
2. Sit in a quiet, comfy area with your child.
3. Begin by doing a "picture walk" through the story with your child. Point to each picture and say what it is or what it is doing. Ask your child what each picture is; to use their words to tell.
4. The second time, read through the story. Remember to point to each word as you are reading to build child's print awareness.
5. Read this book again before bedtime.



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### Milestones to meet:

The child builds early language development through story telling. The child can say or repeat words they hear or pictures they recognize.

### Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
