

Objective: The child builds early language skills after hearing a story and can say words of things they see and recognize in a story.

Materials needed:

eStorybook "I love to learn" (printable)

Procedures:

- 1. Print out the book and staple together. (you can also do this activity straight from the screen at your computer instead of printing)
- 2. Sit in a quiet, comfy area with your child.
- 3. Begin by doing a "picture walk" through the story with your child. Point to each picture and say what it is or what it is doing. Ask your child what each picture is; to use their words to tell.
- 4. The second time, read through the story.

 Remember to point to each word as you are reading to build child's print awareness.
- 5. Read this book again before bedtime.



Milestones to meet:

The child builds early language development through story telling. The child can say or repeat words they hear or pictures they recognize.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
