

Objective: The child enhances their able to create and express themselves through art.

Materials needed:

Goldie the Goldfish (printable)

Real Goldfish Crackers

Glue

Yellow/Orange crayons

Procedures:

- 1. Do this activity with your child sitting at a table.
- 2. Let your child create a goldfish picture with the materials listed above.
- 3. Have them color it first.
- 4. You may have to help your child put dots of glue on the fish, and then allow them to put on the goldfish crackers for décor on the glue dots on the fish.
- 5. Do not "tell" how to create their fish; let them decorate and design it freely on their own.



6. Optional: Let your child "think-outside-the-box"!!! Ask them if there are other items or materials they can use to decorate their goldfish. Such as: Yellow tissue paper, sand, or gold beads/sequins.

Milestones to meet:

The child can use creative thinking to design and create. The child begins to learn how to use glue. The child can color.

Evaluation:
