



In My Suitcase

1 year—2 years

Objective: The child is introduced to real-life items and objects that someone may pack in their suitcase when going on a trip.

Materials needed:

In My Suitcase Picture Cards (printable)

Suitcase (You can choose to use a real suitcase, or the picture of one found on the printable sheet)

Procedures:

1. Cut out all of the "in my suitcase" picture cards individually.
2. One at a time, hold up to show your child and say the name of it to them. Go through until all are shown and said. Encourage child to repeat saying the words of pictures after you.
3. Put each picture card inside the real suitcase, (or tape them each on the picture suitcase), and sing this fun, short song to your child.....



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"We're going on a trip...a trip, a trip"

"We're packing up our things and going on a trip"

"We put it in our suitcase...our suitcase, our suitcase"

We have to pack our suitcase when going on a trip"

Milestones to meet:

The child learns real-life objects. The child begins to associate things they recognize in their own life. The child tries to repeat words after hearing and seeing pictures.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
